



**1/2021. (VII.09.) Instruction of the Dean for  
registration and fulfilment exam courses  
at the Faculty of Public Health**


The Dean of the Faculty of Public Health - acting within the competence set forth in Section 30 (8) (e) of the Organizational and Operational Rules of the University of Debrecen - issues the following instruction:

Exam course can be announced for a subject which requires a terminal examination. The student submits a request for the announcement and admission for an exam course; in case of exam course for the spring semester, no later than the last day of the winter examination period, in case of exam course for the autumn semester, by 31 July.

The Dean of the Faculty decides on the approval of the request. The student can take an exam from the subject taken as an exam course in the first two weeks of the study period, in case of successful completion the student can register for the subject announced in the current semester, for which s/he has completed the exam course as a prerequisite. Registration for an exam course is included in the period for choosing courses, so it is added to the number of the registered courses, and the semester (even if the student fails to complete the exam course) is considered as an active semester. For the first two weeks of the semester, the instructor is obliged to announce at least one exam opportunity for the subject taken as an exam course, the instructor of the subject decides on the announcement of further exam opportunities.

This instruction of the Dean shall enter into force on 09 July 2021 and shall be valid until revoked.
