
Do you know that being a university town, Debrecen has an exciting student-life?

Its historical roots reach back to the foundation of the Reformed College of Debrecen (1538), whose three academic sections later served as the base for the Hungarian Royal University of Sciences, created by Statute no. 36 in 1912.
